'Well, that's all over for a while' was a remark heard after all the Holy Week and Easter services were over.

'There's a break now til Harvest and Remembrance and the run up to Christmas, - but we don't want to think about that yet!'

Perhaps it's because we have holidays and celebrations at Easter that we forget that things are certainly not over and done with. The Easter story celebrates the bedrock of our Christian faith - that Jesus Christ died and rose again from the dead. We heard the stories of how Jesus' disciples saw him, after the resurrection, and that he talked to them at different times and in different places. However, that was certainly not the end of the story. The disciples didn't just carry on as before, nor could they just go back to work or to their homes, on the off chance that Jesus would appear now and again to help them on their way. Life for them, after the resurrection could never be the same again.

Jesus had to leave the earth, and leave his disciples. He couldn't just come and go indefinitely. The day we commemorate his leaving the earth finally is called Ascension Day and this year it comes on May 31st. St Mark tells us that 'he was taken into heaven and took his seat at the right hand of God.' However, before he went he made it quite plain to the disciples what was expected of them. 'Go to every part of the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole of creation'.

St Matthew adds a comforting bit - Jesus said 'I will be with you always'. The resurrection was not the end for the disciples, or for us either. It is not 'over for a while' because our task is to obey Jesus' command and proclaim the gospel to those around us, and to do it all the year round. How we do that we must work out for ourselves, and we will all be different. Find out from page 13 in this magazine how you can celebrate the end and the beginning of God's Kingdom coming to earth.

Darnhall WI

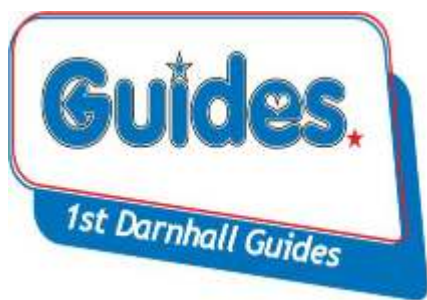

RECIPE

Banana Souffle

Serves 4-5

Ingredients:

3-4 Bananas

3 Eggs

1oz / 25g Caster Sugar

1 Large Orange

1 Tablespoon of Flour

Method

Pulp the bananas, add sugar, grated rind & juice of orange and flour.

Beat in the egg yolks one by one. Whip whites of eggs and stir into mixture.

Pour Mixture into buttered souffle dish or cake tin and bake in hot oven until well risen and firm when touched - about 20 minutes.

Sift with Caster Sugar and serve at once.

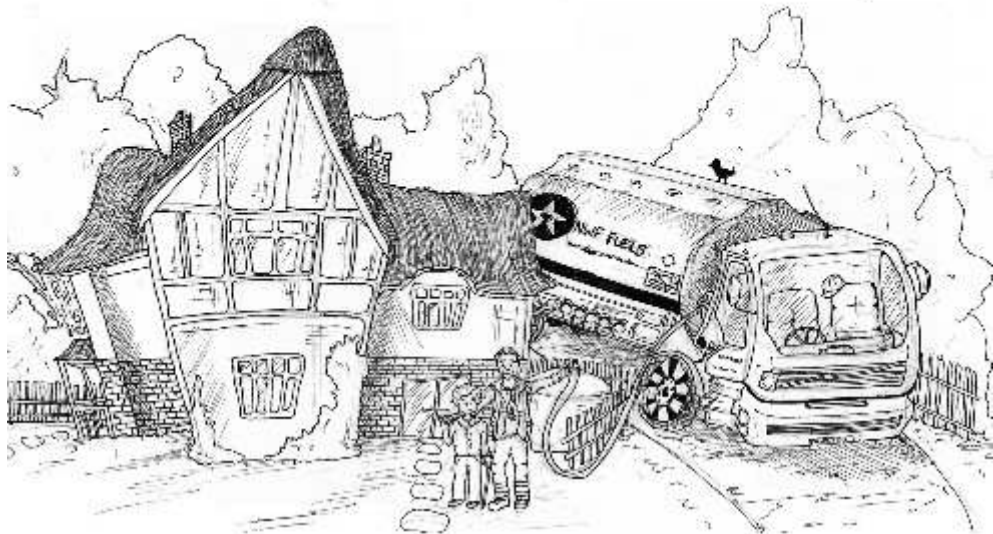
