The wonderful thing is that when we remember Him in this way He actually becomes present to us. Not physically present, but nevertheless really present.

Memories are like the visit of a friend and something to cherish. Whatever helps you to remember, I pray that this November, your thoughts are focused on the happy times and the many blessings that friends and family bring throughout our lives. After all, precious memories are made of this......

Worleston School News

Dear Parents and Carers.

Namaste! I want to take this opportunity to thank you for all your encouragement and support with my trip to Nepal this summer. My month away was challenging, rewarding and made me fall in love with such a beautiful country.

I went over to Nepal, at the start of August, as part of an LRTT charity team. This charity works to improve sustainability in education, around the world and I feel lucky to have been part of this. We were based in Kathmandu, where we worked with the Nepali charity 'Volunteers Initiative Nepal', whose main aim is to help improve lives across Nepal, through a range of different projects (including school projects). Our month started by learning about the Nepali school system and how it differed from our own. After this, we got the opportunity to go into schools, meet the head teachers and observe a range of teachers' lessons. These observations then became the basis for our conference planning. We were given one piece of sugar paper and one day to plan a four-day conference made up of 20 training sessions – it was hard work. The conference itself was a huge success. In pairs we worked alongside 10-15 Nepali

teachers in building up their confidence, skills and knowledge. The conference provided opportunities for me to teach, but also to learn so much from the Nepali teachers. Finally, we got the opportunity to return to schools and see how they had put the training into practice, as well as giving them feedback.

Amongst all this, I had the opportunity to become immersed in Nepali life and learn about their culture and traditions. We went to the jungle, the lakes and even got to see Mount Everest.

I have taken so much away from my trip and hope to pass on so much of what I have learnt and the small changes we can make. I hope that in the future I can continue to work with such a kind, caring and welcoming country.



RECIPE

Stuffed Courgettes

There has been a glut of courgettes this year so this recipe is by courtesy of my friend, Ruth Simpson who, 40 years ago, had a recipe book, '100 Ways with Minced Beef' published by Letts. She doesn't think it's still in print! I have always found it useful.

Serves: 4

Ingredients

6-8 courgettes - depending on size

2 oz/50gm onion, chopped

4 oz/100gm minced beef

2 oz/50gm breadcrumbs

1 teaspoon marjoram

1/2 pint/250 ml cheese sauce

2 oz/50gm grated cheese salt and pepper to taste oil for frying



Method

- Boil the courgettes for 5 minutes.
- Cut in half and scoop out the centres.
- Chop the centres and fry with the onion and minced beef.
- Mix the breadcrumbs into this meat mixture, and add seasoning and marjoram.
- Put the mixture into the courgette shells and place in a greased ovenproof dish.
- Spoon over the cheese sauce to cover the tops and sprinkle with grated cheese.
- Bake in a moderate oven:
 350F/Mark 4/175C for 20 minutes.
